#### **Additional Rules of Entry**

- Cages will be assigned by the Superintendents. No rabbits are to be put into cages until assignment has been made.
   Failure to comply with this rule could mean disqualification.
- Exhibitors must bring their animal(s) to the table to be judged.
- Exhibitors will be responsible for the feeding and care of their exhibits. Feed and water containers must be supplied. No paper containers will be allowed. (e.i. tuna fish cans).
- Crossbred or neutered rabbits must be exhibited in Pet Class.
- All rabbits will be judged according to the American Rabbit Breeders Association Book of Standards.
- All rabbits must meet the weight requirements for their breed.
- Litters, or does ready for kindling, may not be exhibited.
- Classes R and X are open only to those breeds not listed in the other division.
- It is recommended that all Rabbits be at least 8 weeks old.
- All rabbits must be in possession of the exhibitor by July 1 of fair year. Violators will not receive premiums.
- No premise ID number is needed for Rabbits.
